School Fees 2010/2011

Fees for the 2010/2011 Academic Year

The following fee structure will come into effect from September 2010 and is applicable for the 2010-11 academic year. It provides details of all fees associated with educating your child at St Margaret's School, the discounts available and the various methods of payment.

Academic Tuition

Reception	£1,670 per term
Pre-Prep (Years 1 - 2)	£1,765 per term
Prep Fees (Years 3 - 6)	£2,700 per term
Senior Fees (Years 7 - 13)	£3,250 per term

Sibling Discounts

A reduction of £40.00 per term is given for the second child and £45.00 per term for third and subsequent children who also attend St Margaret's. Where brothers or sisters attend other schools within the Woodard Corporation, a discount will be granted.

Lunches

Up to and including year 11, all pupils are required to take lunch in the school dining hall for which a charge of £210.00 per term is made which is billed at the end of each term. The cost per girl is the same throughout the school. From year 12 onwards, girls may opt to bring their own lunches.

Examination Fees and Other Extras

Examination Fees (e.g. GCSE, AS, A2 and Music Grades) and other extras will be charged in arrears.

After School Club

The school runs a daily After School Club from 3.40pm to 6.00pm for children in Years 1-6, to help parents who are working and unable to collect their children earlier. To cover the cost of staffing and the provision of snacks the school makes a small charge.

Registration and Deposit Fees

A child may be registered with St Margaret's for the payment of £50. Registration fees are chargeable to new parents prior to their daughter joining the school. Once offered, a place cannot be secured until we are in receipt of the acceptance form and deposit. This is applicable from Reception. The deposit amount is £150. For Pupils entering the Senior School, a confirmation deposit is required during the summer term in the calendar year preceding entry. The attention of all parents is drawn to the school's current standard terms and conditions of contract which detail the requirement to pay fees in lieu following the removal of a child from the school without appropriate prior notice being given.

Individual tuition in Music

St Margaret's encourages as many pupils as possible to learn one or more musical instruments. It therefore subsidizes instrument hire and makes a nominal termly charge of £10.00 to cover maintenance and repairs. Instrument hire and the termly music maintenance charge are added to your daughter's school bill.

Speech & Drama lessons

In addition to the normal curriculum provision, Speech and Drama may also be taken. The visiting teachers of Music and Speech & Drama will bill you directly at the beginning of each term.

Music

Individual lessons (professional grade) / Shared Lessons

The visiting Music Teachers at St Margaret's are self-employed and exact fees for lessons may be obtained directly from them. Fees will vary according to experience but will be in line with those recommended by the Incorporated Society of Music Masters and Mistresses' Association.

Children Aged Three to Five.

From September 2010 children will be entitled to an allowance of 15 funded hours per week during the school term. The EYEE is available from the term following a child's third birthday. We offer the free entitlement between 8:00 am to 6:00 pm every week day during the school term. Parents are able to take between 2 ½ and 10 hours in one day, 12 ½ hours over two days and no more than 15 hours over a minimum of three days.

St Margaret's School charges £7.60 between the hours of Midday and 1:00 pm to cover the cost of the school lunch, however, parents have the option of providing a healthy snack/packed lunch for their child instead.

Parents may access St Margaret's Nursery Sessions at the following rates when the Free EYEE Entitlement of 15 hours per week is exceeded:
