Fees for 2009/2010 Academic Year

Fees for the 2009/2010 Academic Year

The following fees for tuition and other services provided to pupils by St Margaret's School are effective for the 2009/2010 academic year.

Academic Tuition

Junior Fees (Years 3 - 6)	£2,580 per term
Senior Fees (Years 7 - 13)	£3,110 per term

Sibling Discounts

A reduction of £40.00 per term is given for the second child, and £45.00 per term for third and subsequent children who also attend St Margaret's. Where brothers or sisters attend other schools within the Woodard Corporation, a discount will be granted.

Lunches

Up to and including year 11, all pupils are required to take lunch in the school dining hall for which a charge of £195.00 per term is made which is billed at the end of each term. The cost per girl is the same throughout the school. From year 12 onwards, girls may opt to bring their own lunches.

Examination Fees and Other Extras

Examination Fees (e.g. GCSE, AS, A2 and Music Grades) and other extras will be charged in arrears.

After School Club

The school runs a daily After School Club from 3.30pm to 6.00pm for children in Years 3-6, to help parents who are working and unable to collect their children earlier. To cover the cost of staffing and the provision of snacks the school makes a small charge.

Registration Fees

Registration fees are chargeable to new parents prior to, and deposits chargeable upon, their daughter joining the school. These are advised individually. The attention of all parents is drawn to the school's current standard terms and conditions of contract which detail the requirement to pay fees in lieu following the removal of a child from the school without appropriate prior notice being given.

Individual tuition in Music and Speech & Drama

St Margaret's encourages as many pupils as possible to learn one or more musical instruments. It therefore subsidizes instrument hire and makes a nominal termly charge of £7.00 to cover maintenance and repairs. Instrument hire and the termly music maintenance charge are added to your daughter's school bill. Speech & Drama lessons, in addition to the normal curriculum provision, may also be taken. The visiting teachers of Music and Speech & Drama will bill you directly at the beginning of each term.

Music

Individual lessons (professional grade)/ Shared Lessons

The Visiting Music Teachers at St Margaret's are self-employed and exact fees for lessons may be obtained directly from them. Fees will vary according to experience but will be in line with those recommended by the Incorporated Society of Music Masters and Mistresses' Association.
