

UNIFORM LIST: SENIOR SCHOOL - Years 7-11

We have high expectations of all pupils, both in academic achievement and personal development. This includes their standard of dress and appearance. Pupils are required to conform to the uniform lists and regulations which clearly follow the traditions and values of the school.

All clothes must be marked with nametapes sewn on. Shoes and other items with rigid surfaces should be clearly marked in black ink, or with adhesive nametapes. Large nametapes, one inch wide, with Christian name as initial only and full Surname e.g. L Smith, which can be obtained through the School Outfitters, must be sewn on the outside of PE uniform items as indicated below.

Shoes must be plain black leather, with maximum heel height of 5cm.
Trainers are not acceptable.
